Give yourself the gift of time this holiday season, and steer your Internet browser to Texas.gov/Driver. From there, you can quickly take care of the following:

- [Renew Your Driver License](#) – You may be eligible to renew online up to a year before and a year after your expiration date. You can also change your address online if you've recently moved.
- [Renew Your Vehicle Registration](#) – Renew your registration and sign up for an email reminder for next year. If your registration has already expired, no problem. You have up to six months following the expiration date to renew online.
- [Order Driver Records](#) – Print a copy of your driving record for insurance or other purposes.
- [Check Driving Eligibility & Pay Reinstatement Fees](#) – Check the status of your driving eligibility or pay fees to have your license reinstated.

In 2013 alone, Texans have completed more than 4.3 million transactions via Texas.gov for these driving related services.
